ADDITIONAL GUIDANCE – YEARS 5-6

T-Shirts

If worn t-shirts must not be visible at the neck.

Trousers

Trousers must be plain black. Skin-tight trousers/leggings, jeans-style trousers or trousers with visible zips or decorative buttons on the front or back are not acceptable.

Skirts

Skirts must be knee-length and not tight-fitting.

Jewellery

No jewellery is permitted in the Academy other than one pair of stud earrings. If a stud earring is worn it should be plain, small and in the lower ear lobe only. Any item of jewellery that a student may wish to wear for religious or cultural importance may be allowed if parents contact the relevant Year Leader to request permission for this.

Piercings

No face or body piercings are allowed.

Make-Up

Make-up and nail varnish/nail art are not permitted.

Hair

Hair colour should be restricted to 'natural' colours (ie. blonde, brunette, black or auburn) and styles should not be too extreme e.g. no stripes of colour or shaved patterns. Any hair accessories should be 'simple' and longer hair must be tied back.

ADDITIONAL GUIDANCE – YEAR 7-10 ONLY

T-Shirts

If worn t-shirts must not be visible at the neck.

Trousers

Trousers must be plain black. Skin-tight trousers/leggings, jeans-style trousers or trousers with visible zips or decorative buttons on the front or back are not acceptable.

Skirts

Skirts must be knee-length and not tight-fitting.

Jewellery

No jewellery is permitted in the Academy other than one pair of stud earrings. If a stud earring is worn it should be plain, small and in the lower ear lobe only. Any item of jewellery that a student may wish to wear for religious or cultural importance may be allowed if parents contact the relevant Year Leader to request permission for this.

Piercings

No face or body piercings are allowed.

Make-Up

Year 9/10 girls are allowed light make up. Nail varnish/nail art and false eyelashes are not permitted.

Hair

Hair colour should be restricted to 'natural' colours (ie. blonde, brunette, black or auburn) and styles should not be too extreme e.g. no stripes of colour or shaved patterns. Any hair accessories should be 'simple' and although girls may keep their hair loose, longer hair must be tied back during practical lessons.
