Year 5 English	<p><u>Biography + Play scripts</u> Pupils will read aloud this half term and learn how to RESCUE words that they don't understand in order to improve their vocabulary. The grammar and punctuation focus for this half term will be the introduction of relative pronouns and relative clauses.</p>	<p><u>Journalistic Writing + Formal Writing</u> Pupils will be encouraged to ask questions about the texts that they are reading to aid understanding. They will also look at identifying the audience and purpose of a piece of writing and the impact that this has on their writing. The grammar and punctuation focus for this half term will be the use of modal verbs to indicate a degree of possibility.</p>	<p><u>Narrative + Instructions</u> Pupils will begin to look at using evidence from the text to support their understanding. They will also look at inference and what message the author is trying to convey. The grammar and punctuation focus for this half term will be: the introduction of the perfect tense, using commas to avoid ambiguity, develop the use of relative clauses within writing and begin to look at the uses of colons and semi-colons.</p>	<p><u>Persuasive + Film Narrative</u> Pupils will look at the difference between fact and opinion and also work on being able to justify their thoughts and opinions about a text. The grammar and punctuation focus for this half term will be the introduction of parenthesis, continuing to use commas to clarify meaning and looking at formal structures.</p>	<p><u>Poems + Report Writing</u> Pupils will focus on looking at a range of poetry types and learning one by heart to perform. They will discuss and evaluate how authors use language including figurative language, considering the impact on the reader. The grammar and punctuation focus for this half term will be the use of brackets and developing the use of expanded noun phrases to add meaning.</p>	<p><u>Myths and Ledgens + Discussion</u> Pupils will make comparisons within and across books and justify their inference with evidence from the text. The grammar and punctuation focus for this half term will be revision of all grammar and punctuation covered so far.</p>
<p>Spelling rules and patterns and revision of the Year 3, 4 and 5 grammar and punctuation terminology will be covered throughout the year.</p> <p>The different tense forms will be taught throughout the year.</p>
